further to amend the Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University Act, 2010.

Preamble.—WHEREAS, it is expedient further to amend the Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University Act, 2010 (Act 3 of 2011) for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

BE it enacted in the Seventy-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (Amendment) Act, 2022.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Substitution of new section for section 58.—In the Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University Act, 2010 (Act 3 of 2011), for section 58, the following section shall be substituted, namely:—
- "58. Reservation of appointments.—In making appointments to the teaching and non-teaching posts, the University shall, *mutatis-mutandis*, observe the provisions of clauses (a), (b) and (c) of rule 14 and the provisions of rules 15,16,17 and 17 A of the Kerala State and Subordinate Services Rules, 1958, as amended from time to time, and communal rotation shall be followed category—wise treating all the departments as one unit."

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

As per section 58 of the Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University Act, 2010 (Act 3 of 2011), the rules for the reservation of appointments to posts

under the Government in favour of Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes shall apply in the case of appointment of the teachers and non-teaching staff and other employees of the University. The Government consider it necessary to have a uniform provision in respect of reservation and communal rotation for appointments to the teaching and non-teaching posts in the Universities in the State to follow communal rotation category-wise treating all the departments as one unit. For this purpose, the Government have decided to amend the said provision of the Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University Act, 2010 (Act 3 of 2011) in tune with the University Laws (Second Amendment) Act, 2014 (Act 26 of 2014) so as to achieve uniformity with the provisions of other University Acts regarding reservation pattern and communal rotation in respect of appointments to the teaching and non-teaching posts.

The Bill is intended to achieve the above said object.

FINANCIAL MEMORANDUM

The Bill, if enacted and brought into operation, would not involve any additional expenditure from the Consolidated Fund of the State.
